SPIRITS

Ouzo

Originating in Northeastern Greece, in particular the small city of Komotini in the 19th century, this is Greece's most iconic and traditional spirit, renowned for its strong anise flavour and the ability to turn milky white when mixed with water/ice

Tsipouro

a traditional Greek pomace brandy, distilled from grape skins, seeds, and pulp, produced in clear and aged (oak-matured) varieties, originating from regions like Thessaly and Macedonia.

Harvested from the Mastic tree which is found on the Greek island of Chios - the only place in the world where it is grown.

The tree is said to "shed tears of resin."
