COCKTAILS - CLASSIC

The French Martini

A sumptuous pink colour issued from the famous Chambord vodka; it gives a nod to its heritage - it's Louis XIV who first sampled the liqueur 25

Cosmopolitan

A favourite for celebrities from Miami to New York, this famous cocktail is made with vodka, triple sec, cranberry juice, freshly squeezed lime, gossip and laughter 25

Kir Royale

Crème de cassis with French Champagne, created by a Catholic priest in France, his cocktail creations were part of his resistance to the Nazis. A true hero who helped rescue many prisoners of war 25

Margarita

Part of the daisy family of cocktails, popular in the early 20th century, containing Don Julio Blanco tequila, citrus juice, an orange liqueur and sugar syrup 27

Aperol Spritz

This popular aperitif is as visually pleasing as it is tasty: a three-two-one ratio of Prosecco, Aperol and Soda 25

Hugo Spritz

This refreshing cocktail is a popular, sweeter alternative to an Aperol Spritz, characterized by its floral, crisp, and herbaceous taste. It is made with Prosecco, elderflower liqueur, soda water, and fresh mint 25

Negroni

Story goes that the drink was invented in Florence in 1919 when Count Negroni asked for a slug of gin in his Americano in place of the soda. So, the aromatic and dangerously alcoholic Negroni was born 25

Manhattan

The most famous cocktail in the world shortly after it was invented in New York City's Manhattan Club, sometime around 1880 (as the story goes). Two parts Chivas Regal 18 YO whiskey, one-part sweet vermouth and bitters. Stirred, never shaken 27

Old Fashioned

The sophisticated cocktail, with a blend of bourbon, bitters and sugar, garnished with orange zest, made its first appearance in 1806 primarily consumed first thing in the morning as a remedy for headaches and nausea 25

The Greek Old Fashioned

Aristotle Onassis' favourite drink while at sea, this Old Fashioned features Greece's iconic spirit Metaxa 12 Star, baklava syrup and bitters, garnished with maraschino cherries 44

COCKTAILS - SIGNATURE

Zorba the Greek

Sip a mixture of whiskey and Amaretto and channel your inner Zorba, but remember his 6 words. "This drink is not for amateurs" 25

Black Rose

This koukla is sweet and seductive. While it may look as feminine as a flower with its blackberry ingredients, don't be fooled; its dose of French Vermouth and Crème de cassis certainly packs a punch 25

Aphrodite

The rum component, with an emphasis on oak overtones makes this mythological cocktail full of a complex array of flavours that shall evoke the goddess of love and beauty 25

The Spartan

Strong and Magnificent, Grand Marnier and Vodka based with Coca-Cola, this secret combination shall create magic for you... 25

One Night in Paros

Sweet and bright in colour and flavour with tequila, raspberry ouzo, grenadine and orange juice, this cocktail will make you dance all night 25

Santorini Sunset

Meet me in Santorini, a favourite for lovers. This Grecian cocktail is made with ouzo and blue curacao and will have you dreaming 25

Retsina

Retsina is a traditional Greek white wine infused with pine resin, originating in ancient Greece 2000 years ago when winemakers sealed clay amphorae with Aleppo pine resin to block out oxygen. This infused the wine with a signature piney, resinous aroma.

In 2008 European regulations (including Council Regulation EC No 491/2009) formally codified the exact geographical and compositional standards of Retsina, stating it can only be produced in Greece (and select regions in Cyprus) using Aleppo pine resin.

Mastic Trees of Chios Island

Mastic Liqueur from Chios

The Mastiha tree only grows on one island in the world, the island of Chios (north-east of the Aegean Sea).

Its bark is scraped off and the sap flowing from it produces what are called Mastiha's tears, which fall from the tree and dry naturally in the sun. The tears are then scraped off and cleaned by hand. It is from these tears that the Mastiha liqueur is produced.

Ancient Greeks used Mastic (Mastiha) as a remedy for stomach aches, a tradition that continues today for aiding digestion.

2017 Muscat of Samos - *Samos, Greece*

Samos dessert wine, crafted from high-altitude Muscat grapes on the Greek island of Samos, is a 3,000-year-old tradition spanning from ancient mythology to modern global acclaim.

Aromas of apricot and ripe melon lead to a palate of lush summer fruits, butterscotch, and caramel 12

METAXA

A unique Greek amber spirit created in 1888 by Spyros Metaxas.

Wanting a smoother, less harsh alternative to existing brandies, he blended aged wine distillates with sweet Muscat wines from the Aegean Islands and a secret botanical recipe.
